TO TACTICAL PROFESSIONALS INC. DBA TAC PRO SHOOTING CENTER:

In consideration of the opportunity afforded to me or my minor child/ward to use the Tac Pro Shooting Center ranges, I, the undersigned, on behalf of myself or my child/ward named herein, do freely agree to make the following contractual representations and agreements.

I, on behalf of myself or my child/ward named herein, understand the inherent risks associated with participation in this type of activity and do hereby knowingly, freely, and voluntarily assume all liability for any damage or injury that may occur as a result of my or my child/ward's use of the target ranges and agree to **release, waive, discharge, and covenant not to sue Tactical Professionals Inc. dba Tac Pro Shooting Center**, its officers, agents, employees, and volunteers from any and all liability or claims that may be sustained by me, my minor child/ward, or a third party directly or indirectly in connection with, or arising out of, the use of the target ranges, **whether caused in whole or in part by the negligence of Tactical Professionals Inc. dba Tac Pro Shooting Center or otherwise.**

I, on behalf of myself or my child/ward, have read the above provision, fully understand its terms, and understand that I, on behalf of myself or my child/ward, have given up substantial rights by signing this contract, and I have signed it freely and without inducement or assurance of any nature and intend it to be a complete and unconditional release of any and all liability to the greatest extent allowed by law and agree that, if any portion of this contract is held to be invalid, the balance notwithstanding shall continue in full force and effect.

TAC PRO SHOOTING CENTER RULES & REGULATIONS

GUN HANDLING

- ALWAYS KEEP THE GUN POINTED IN A SAFE DIRECTION
- ALWAYS KEEP YOUR FINGER OFF THE TRIGGER & OUTSIDE THE TRIGGER GUARD UNTIL READY TO SHOOT
- ALWAYS KEEP GUNS UNLOADED AND IN CASES / HOLSTERED OR ACTION OPEN UNTIL IN POSITION ON THE FIRING LINE AND THE RANGE HAS BEEN CLEARED FOR LIVE FIRING.
- KNOW YOUR TARGET AND WHAT IS BEYOND.
- BE SURE THE GUN IS SAFE TO OPERATE
- KNOW HOW TO USE THE GUN YOU ARE USING, SAFELY
- USE ONLY THE CORRECT AMMUNITION FOR YOUR GUN.
- WEAR EYE AND EAR PROTECTION
- NEVER USE ALCOHOL OR DRUGS BEFORE OR WHILE SHOOTING
- STORE GUNS SO THEY ARE NOT ACCESSIBLE TO UNAUTHORIZED PERSONS

RANGE RULES

- Know and obey all range commands.
- Shoot only at authorized targets.
- Ground level targets are not authorized without a proper backstop. Maintain the proper target height to ensure that the fired projectile, after passing through the target, hits the desired portion of the backstop. This will reduce the possibility of ricochets and projectiles escaping the property.
- Designate a range officer when none is present or assigned.
- Do NOT handle any firearm while others are down range.
- Always keep the muzzle pointed at the backstop and parallel to the ground. Never allow the muzzle to point in any direction whereby an inadvertent discharge would allow the escape of a projectile into an outer area.

SPECIFIC RANGE RULES

- **No armor piercing or Steel core ammunition to be used on steel plate targets.** Any person causing damage by inappropriate behavior on the ranges or property will be charged and may be forced to forfeit their membership.
- Only shoot at paper or steel targets designated by Tac Pro Shooting Center.
- Before leaving the range, all paper targetry and trash must be disposed of in trash cans provided and all ammunition brass / empty cases must be picked up and put into buckets provided, unless patrons wish to keep their own brass / empty cases. **Please leave the ranges tidy.**
- Anyone found consuming alcohol or drugs or in the opinion of the range officer is under the influence of alcohol or drugs will be asked to leave the property immediately and / or relinquish their membership or be barred.
- The range officers' decisions are final – no ungentlemanly conduct.
- No Toy / imitation Guns allowed on Tac Pro Shooting Center Property.
- Due to possible fire hazards, patrons wishing to use potential incendiary devices (including black powder firearms, tracer ammunition, flash bangs etc.) must have prior permission from Tac Pro Shooting Center range officers before use on that day.
- Minimum safety distance to steel targets is **15 yards** .
- On Sporting clays / skeet ranges, no bird shot larger than number 4 is permitted.
- Due to potential fire hazards, smoking is only permitted in designated areas.
- All vehicles and pedestrians must stay on main gravel roads. Tac Pro Shooting Center property is private property and will not tolerate trespassers.
- Tac Pro Shooting Center is not responsible or liable for any loss, accidents or damage to any person or property whilst on Tac Pro Shooting Center property.
- **Do not drive any sort of vehicle on any of the ranges.**
